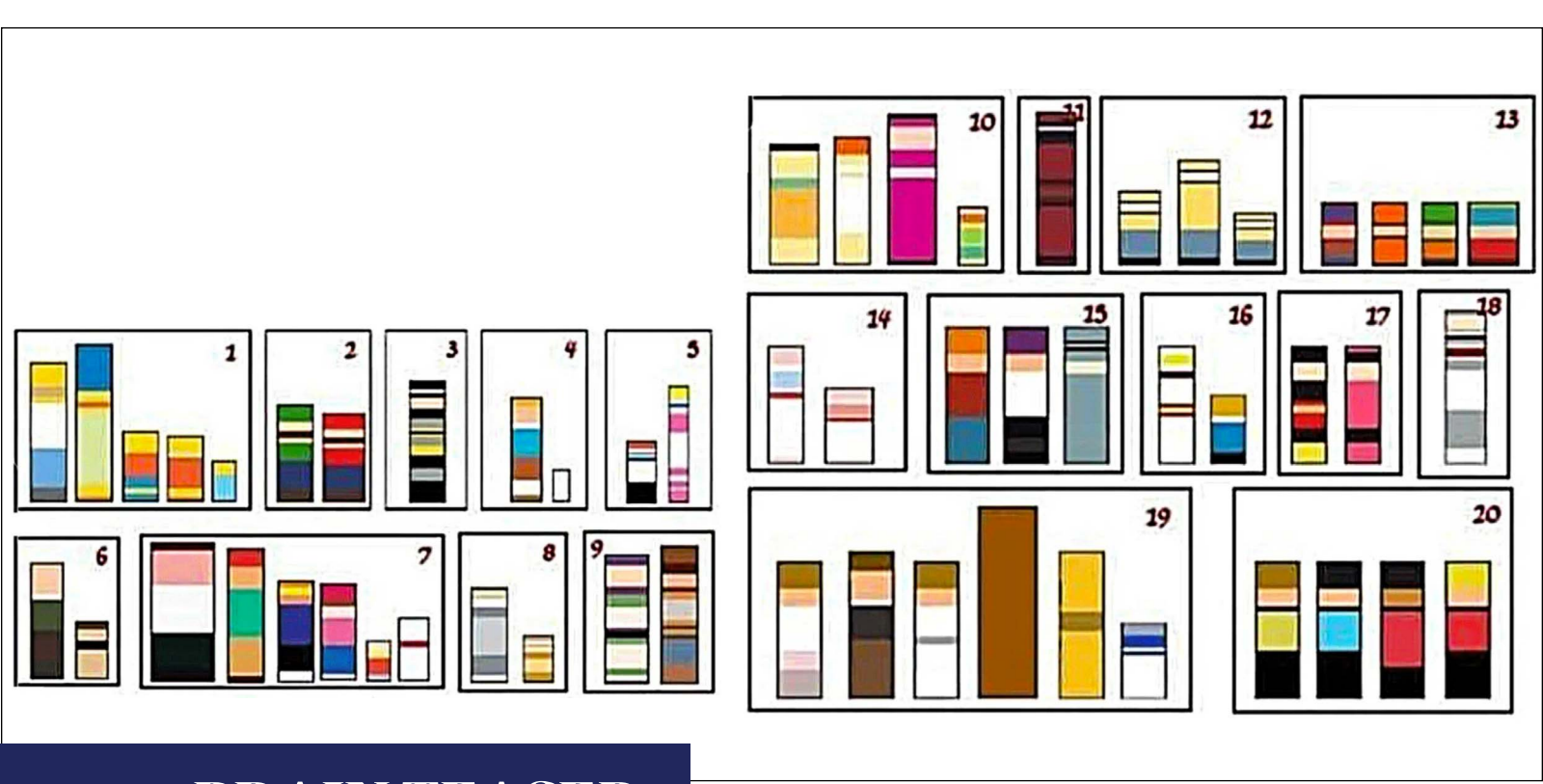
A cat named Penelope was [formerly reported to Human Resources](#) for her mischievous ways, as her humans try their best to WFH.
